



Assistance in requesting a tenth of a DNIC

References to standards

On request, the office allocates one tenth of a DNIC code to anyone offering a national or regional packet data transmission service interconnected with equivalent international services according to ITU-T Recommendation X.75.

Format

The remaining nine-tenths of a DNIC code are reserved for future needs, in principle those of the holder of the first tenth.

The office may share a DNIC among multiple holders from the time when 75 % of the DNIC codes allocated to Switzerland are occupied.

Rules for allocation

The application must contain the following information:

- the numbering plan of the data network;
- the assignment of numbers;
- the actual and planned number of subscribers;
- the various services offered.

The tenths of a DNIC code are allocated in the order in which applications are received.
